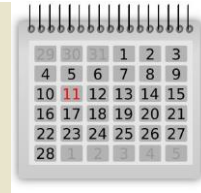

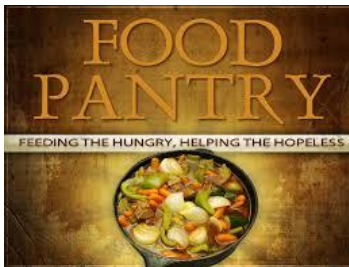
**Life Line Screening**
